My party representative can also request the right of access to all my previous cases in the Immigration Service.

The power of attorney automatically ends when the Immigration Service has completed the processing of the cases that are included in the power of attorney, and any appeal deadlines have expired. I can always withdraw the power of attorney by contacting the Immigration Service.
